Mandatory Funds are Bonding, Department Scholarship, Girls State Project, Veterans 1st Fund, Poppy Order & 10% Poppy Proceeds. Make check payable to Department Treasurer, ALA. DUE into Department July 31st to be a Unit in good standing.

**Processing Membership:** Make sure your membership is into Department Headquarters by the 15th to be counted for Targets.

**Membership:** All applications must have signature of a Post Officer and if they are a Junior member a Birthdate. **Unit Membership Chairman should** check each application to make sure it is filled out completely including City, Post #, State and zip code. If eligibility is under a Veteran living all information must be filled out before processing into Department Head**quarters**. If a veteran is living they must hold membership in The American Legion. All unfinished applications will be returned this year. Please check the Birthdates of your Juniors renewing this year. If they will

Juniors renewing this year. If they will turn 18 years old by December 31, 2014 they are considered a Senior Member.

Remember: if a Woman Veteran joins the Auxiliary under herself you must put on the application at the top

"Honor Our Women Veterans" to get the discount from National. Unit Secretary can sign these applications ONLY.

This will continue through the next administrative year.


