Mission Statement

In the spirit of service, not Self, the mission of the American Legion Auxiliary is to support The American Legion and honor the sacrifice of those who serve by enhancing the lives of our veterans, military, and their families, both at home and abroad. For God and Country, we advocate for veterans, educate our citizens, mentor our youth, and promote patriotism, good citizenship, peace and security.

We need to repeat this <u>Mission Statement</u> at each meeting after we say our "Preamble to the Constitution of the American Legion Auxiliary".

Mandatory Funds: to be a unit in good standing one of the obligations is paying your unit mandatory funds yearly, no later than July 31, 2017. If you are attending Department Convention to be seated as a delegate, then it is 30 days before Convention.

Mandatory Funds are: Bonding, Girls State Project, Education, Veterans 1st Fund, Poppies, and 10% proceeds.

Spirits: articles are due into Department the *15th of each month*. Spirit is emailed/mailed by the 20th of each month. If it falls on a weekend then it will be sent on Monday of the next week. *Please limit your article to 200 words or less*.

Membership: National is honoring our "new" women veterans again this year. Please remember to put "Honor Our Female Veterans" at top of application. If a member is rejoining, I don't need an application sent in. You may want one for your records to make sure she is still eligible. If you do send one in, write either "rejoin" or her ID number on the application so she won't be listed as a new member in the system.

Any dues besides 2017 dues are considered "back dues". Please put in the area designated for back dues on your transmittal. Please don't send in 2016 transmittals to pay 2016 dues.

Remember that you must pay 2017 dues first, before back dues.



The American Legion Family will launch National Poppy Day on Friday, May 26, as a way to honor U.S. service members, from the battlefields of France in WWI a century ago, to today's War on Terror. Since the 1920's ALA members have distributed millions of poppies annually across the country in exchange for donations that go directly to assist disabled and hospitalized veterans in our communities. Although the Auxiliary is known for proudly displaying the poppy year-round, be sure to wear a poppy May 26 - the Friday before Memorial Day - in memory of the fallen and to honor those who have fought for our freedom. Boeing Co. is a sponsor of National Poppy Day.

Annual reports reflect the program work of units in each ALA department and collectively help us convey what we're doing to achieve the five goals of the ALA's Centennial Strategic Plan and share our impact on veterans, military, and their families. Department committee chairmen are required to submit a narrative report by May 15 to their division committee chairman. Each department committee chairman should also ensure that her department's ALA Impact Report is submitted. Members and units should follow their department's protocol deadline. National Security

Hello Ladies:

Well, there are several ways that cover the NATIONAL SECURITY PROGRAM. You can get ideas from the units and members as to what they do for this program. Several questions you can answer are basic. Do you do the POW/MIA ceremony? Do you give out the Blue/ Gold Star Banners? Sending care packages to our service members. Have a welcome home party or event. Work with the ROTC program. This is one area of the National Security program.

Another area, is being prepared for emergencies that may occur; as to weather, flood & fire. This would also include the aiding of Senior Citizens, Children and others. You can help people before disaster strikes. Few ideas: Make sure they have medicine enough for a few days, this may be extended for a few days during flood and heavy snow. Have extra food on hand in case of electrical outage, Food that does not need cooked. Always have water on hand., snacks for children. A list of doctors and a medicine list that may be needed for EMT and a Hospital, this could be a life or death situation. Have alternative lighting for the dwelling. Use battery operated flash lights instead on candles; which can cause a fire. Then you have double trouble to deal with. Best idea is to get a storage box to keep these and other items in. Check out periodically to make sure items had not expired.
