#### **Mission Statement**

In the spirit of service, not Self, the mission of the American Legion Auxiliary is to support The American Legion and honor the sacrifice of those who serve by enhancing the lives of our veterans, military, and their families, both at home and abroad. For God and Country, we advocate for veterans, educate our citizens, mentor our youth, and promote patriotism, good citizenship, peace and security.

We need to repeat this <u>Mission Statement</u> at each meeting after we say our "Preamble to the Constitution of the American Legion Auxiliary".

Mandatory Funds: to be a unit in good standing one of the obligations is paying your unit mandatory funds yearly, no later than July 31, 2017. If you are attending Department Convention to be seated as a delegate, then it is 30 days before Convention.

Mandatory Funds are: Bonding, Girls State Project, Education, Veterans 1st Fund, Poppies, and 10% proceeds.

<u>Spirits:</u> articles are due into Department the *15th of each month*. Spirit is emailed/mailed by the 20th of each month. If it falls on a weekend then it will be sent on Monday of the next week. *Please limit your article to 200 words or less.* 

Membership: National is honoring our "new" women veterans again this year. Please remember to put "Honor Our Female Veterans" at top of application. If a member is rejoining, I don't need an application sent in. You may want one for your records to make sure she is still eligible. If you do send one in, write either "rejoin" or her ID number on the application so she won't be listed as a new member in the system.

Any dues besides 2017 dues are considered "back dues". Please put in the area designated for back dues on your transmittal. Please don't send in 2016 transmittals to pay 2016 dues.

Remember that you must pay 2017 dues <u>first</u>, before back dues.

**Poppy Pins:** I have poppy pins in the office for sale at the price I paid for them when I was out in Indianapolis in May. Here is a picture of the poppy pin:



I will bring to convention to sell.

#### **Credentials:**

Please pre register when you send in your credentials. Remember Delegates at Large are to be put on the lines next to this, NOT at the top. Delegates at Large are: Department Officers in your unit, District Presidents in your unit, and Past Department Presidents in your unit. Your unit pays their registration fee. Deadline to be into Department Headquarters will be on the form. Make sure you are using the **revised** credentials form that show \$20.00 for preregistration.

Remember: Credentials are the Unit's registration form for convention. If you pre register and know you are attending, please send in the check.

Hello Ladies

I recently read a good article about Fisher Houses, which is a program the American Legion Auxiliary has supported for many years. It appeared in , the AARP newsletter, and contained a lot of good information. I recommend each unit that can afford it should make a donation each year as a part of their VA&R program.

When a loved one is being treated at a VA or military medical center, the last thing family members needs to worry about is where they can stay and how they can

afford it. For more than 300,000 families the answer has been Fisher Houses, a nationwide network of 71 cozy, well-equipped homes away from home where families can stay at no cost. Since the first Fisher Home opened in 1991, more than 7 million days have been provided.

Each Fisher House can accommodate up to 42 individuals and is close to the medical center or hospital it serves so that families and patients can spend less time traveling and more time together. Families share kitchen, dining living and laundry spaces, but have private bedrooms and bath. The houses are maintained by managers and

volunteers who make sure refrigerators are stocked, gardens tended, and toys available for visiting children.

See why Fisher House is such a good thing to support.

I know the Huntington VAMC has applied and received permission to have a Fisher House, but it takes 5 or 6 million dollars to build one. It will take some serious fund-raising; because, I am sure it has to come from outside sources and not the government.

On a personal note, I want to thank everyone for all the help they have given me as I have served this year as your VA&R Chairman.

# CALL FOR NINETY-FIFTH ANNUAL DEPARTMENT CONVENTION OF THE AMERICAN LEGION AUXILIARY DEPARTMENT OF WEST VIRGINIA, INC.

The Ninety-Fifth Department Convention of the American Legion Auxiliary is hereby called in conformity with Article IX, Section 1 of the Department Constitution and Bylaws which provides, "That the Department Convention be held annually concurrent with the Convention of The American Legion, Department of West Virginia." #### **PURPOSE**

Certification of the election of the delegates and alternates MUST be mailed to Department Headquarters no less than two weeks prior to Convention, and SHALL BE accompanied by the Convention fee of \$15.00 for each accredited delegates so certified.

There shall be the following Standing Committees: Americanism, Auxiliary Emergency Fund, Children & Youth, Community Service, Constitution and Bylaws, Education, Finance, Girls State, Junior Activities, Leadership, Legislative, Membership, National Security, Past Presidents Parley, Poppy, Public Relations, Veterans Affairs & Rehabilitation and Way & Means.

The following Standing Committees, in addition to the Committee members, shall consist of eight District Chairman, one of whom shall be appointed from each District by the District President, for a one-year term. The following Standing Committee, Membership, in addition to the committee members, shall consist of the eight District Vice Presidents, serving the Department as District Membership Chairman.

<u>New Reading:</u> Section 3. There shall be the following Standing Committees: Americanism, Auxiliary Emergency Fund, Children & Youth, Community Service, Constitution and Bylaws, Education, Finance, Girls State, Junior Activities, Leadership, Legislative, Membership, National Security, Past Presidents Parley, Poppy, Public Relations, <u>and</u> Veterans Affairs & Rehabilitation and Way & Means.

The following Standing Committees, in addition to the Committee members, shall consist of <u>all eight</u> District Chairman, one of whom shall be appointed from each District by the District President, for a one-year term. Americanism, Children & Youth, National Security, and Veterans Affairs and Rehabilitation.

The following Standing Committee, Membership, in addition to the committee members, shall consist of <u>all the eight</u> District Vice Presidents, serving the Department as District Membership Chairman.

<u>Rational:</u> Delete Ways and Means as a Committee - It is the duty of the Department Secretary/Treasurer to handle all monies, she is the only one bonded, she needs to handle the Ways and Means because it is a large sum of money.

Delete the word "eight" before District Chairman and District Vice Presidents - Districts can be dissolved or formed at any time. Use of the word "each" prevents the bylaws from being changed each time a district is dissolved or formed.
